

- Salmonids, eel and lamprey in River Elwy. Otter present on River Elwy. Nesting bird habitat.
- Himalyan balsam present on river banks. Records of New Zealand pygmyweed and monkey flower.
- Great Crested Newts known to be present in the local area.
- Risks of encountering unrecorded archaeology.
- Badger sett known to be located close to but outside of working area.

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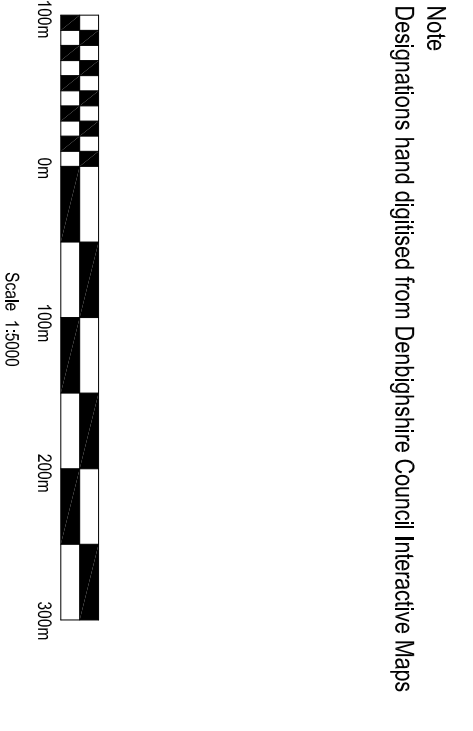
