UCHAFBWYNTIAU

Mwynhewch panorama mynydd syfrdanol gyda Moel Siabod yn erbyn cefndir trawiadol mynyddoedd Carneddau.

Mae'r dringo serth ar ddechrau'r daith gerdded yn werth yr ymdrech wrth ichi ddilyn eich ffordd drwy goed godidog ac anarferol yn yr hen goedfa. Cewch gipolwg ar Gwm Llugwy wrth ichi ddringo, ond dim ond blas yw'r golygfeydd hyn. Ar ben bryncyn, mae mainc ac yno olygfa banoramig fendigedig draw at Foel Siabod, Mynyddoedd Carneddau, ac, ar ddiwrnod clir, gopa Tryfan.

HIGHLIGHTS

Enjoy a stunning mountain panorama with Moel Siabod flanked by the impressive backdrop of the Carneddau mountains.

The steep climb at the start of the walk is worth the effort as you pick your way through some impressive and unusual trees in the old arboretum. You'll catch glimpses of the Llugwy Valley as you climb, but these views are just a taster. On top of a knoll, you will find a bench with a wonderful panoramic view across to Moel Siabod, the Carneddau Mountains, and, on a clear day, the top of Tryfan.

Disgrifiad: Mae'r rhan fwyaf o'r llwybr hwn ar ffyrdd coedwig sydd wedi'u cysylltu gan lwybrau cul o lai na 60cm o led mewn mannau, sy'n arw ac anwastad dan droed, lle gallwch ddisgwyl mwd, creigiau a gwreiddiau coed. Mae'r llwybr yn esgyn yn serth, ac yn disgyn yn raddol. Mae nifer o fyrrdau picnic yn y maes parcio, ac mae mainc wrth yr olygfan.



Follow the red waymarker symbols

Start: Cae'n y Coed car park

Grade: Strenuous

Time: 1½-2hr

Distance: 2 miles/3.3km

Climb: 188m

Description: Most of this trail is on forest roads connected by rough narrow paths less than 60cm wide in some places, on unmade and uneven surfaces, where you can expect mud, rocks and tree roots. The trail has a steep ascent, and a steady descent. There are numerous picnic tables in the car park, and there is a bench at the viewpoint.
