

The ancient county of Ceredigion is characterised by its stunning coastline, remote upland landscape, wonderful wetlands and deep river valleys.


Natural Resources Wales is proud to look after some real gems in this scenically dramatic yet tranquil part of Wales.


Pellter | Distance: 1½m | 2km

UCHAFBWYNTIAU: Taith ysgafn ar hyd afon Ystwyth sy'n dychwelyd drwy goedwig sy'n llawn arogl resin. Mae clychau'r gog yn gorchuddio'r ddaear o dan a coed ffawydd yn y gwanwyn ac mae yna lawer o ffngau yn yr hydref. Efallai y byddwch ddigon ffodus i gael cip ar las y dorlan yn gwibio heibio.


DISGRIFIAD: Mae'r llwybr yn rhwydd ond byddwch yn dod ar draws rhai grisiau a gwreiddiau. Bydd yr arwyneb yn arw ac efallai'n wlyb mewn mannau. Argymhellir esgidiad cerdded sydd â gafael dda. Nid oes dringfeydd dros 17tr / 5m. Bydd angen lefel resymol o ffitrwydd ar gyfer y llwybr hwn.

HIGHLIGHTS: A gentle walk alongside the river Ystwyth returning through woodland filled with the scent of resin. Bluebells carpet the ground under the beech trees in spring and there are lots of fungi in the autumn. You may even catch the lightning streak of a kingfisher hunting along the river.

DESCRIPTION: Easy, but the trail does contain some steps and roots. The surface will be rough and possibly wet in places. Walking shoes with a good grip recommended. There are no climbs over 17tr / 5m. You need a reasonable level of fitness for this walk.


Pellter | Distance: 3½m | 5.5km

Time: 1 hour at a walk

UCHAFBWYNTIAU: Mwynhewch amrywiaeth o arwynebau, coetiroedd ac ardalau aghored ar y llwybr hwn, sydd â golygfeydd pell y tu hwn i'r coetir.

DISGRIFIAD: Ar ôl cychwyn ar ffordd goedwig, yn y man byddwch yn mynd drwy giât llwybrau meddal. Ar ôl rhan sy'n esgyrn yn serth (tua 70m o hyd), byddwch yn dal i ddringo ar llaï serth nes ichi gyrraedd pwnt uchaf y llwybr ger bryngaer Allt Fedw. Oddi yno, mae rhagor o llwybrau meddal tan y pwnt hanner ffordd - ac wedi hynny, byddwch yn dilyn ffordd goedwig yr holl ffordd yn ôl i'r man cychwyn. Gall y llwybr fod yn fwldy a llithrig mewn mannau.

HIGHLIGHTS: Enjoy a variety of surfaces, woodlands and open areas on this trail. Take in distant views beyond the woodland.

DESCRIPTION: After starting out on a forest road you'll soon go through a gate onto soft trails. After a steep section of climb (about 70m long), you'll keep on climbing less steeply until you reach the highest point of the trail near the Allt Fedw hillfort. From there more soft trails await you until you reach the halfway point - after which follow a forest road all the way back to the start. The trail can be muddy and slippery in places.



UCHAFBWYNTIAU: Llyn deniadol a bryngaer Allt Fedw sy'n 2000 o flynyddoedd oed. Yma gallwch edrych ar y golygfeydd panoramig ar hyd galiau a dyffrynoedd tonnog y holl ffordd i Bumlumon, sef mynydd uchaf Canolbarth Cymru.

DISGRIFIAD: Llwybr cymedrol gyda rhai dringfeydd hir a disgyniadau serth. Bydd yr arwyneb yn arw ac efallai'n wlyb mewn mannau. Argymhellir esgidiad cerdded sydd â gafael dda. Bydd angen lefel dda o ffitrwydd ar gyfer y daith gerdded hon.

HIGHLIGHTS: An attractive pond and the 2000 year-old hillfort of Allt Fedw. From there you can take in panoramic views across rolling hills and valleys all the way to Mid Wales' highest mountain, Pumlumon.

DESCRIPTION: A moderate walk with some long climbs and steep descents. The surface will be rough and possibly wet in places. Walking shoes with a good grip recommended. You need a good level of fitness for this walk.

Beth allwch chi ei wneud yma?



A pheasant place to walk
Welcome to Black Covert in the Ystwyth Valley, which got its name from the Trawsgoed (Crosswood) Estate it was once part of.

A 'covert' is an area for raising game, in this case most likely pheasants.

What can you do from here?

Enjoy a picnic sheltered under large ash, birch and sweet chestnut trees with the Afon Ystwyth rushing by. You can either do the gentle **Ystwyth Riverside Walk** or try the more strenuous **Birch Grove Woodland Walk** in the neighbouring woodland. There's also a trail for horseriders.
